The World Youth Alliance (www.wya.net) is a global coalition of young people committed to promoting the dignity of the person and building solidarity among youth from developed and developing nations.

Participants: The scavenger hunt will be geared for ages 18-24, but high school students are welcome. **Minors (below 18 years of age) must have a waiver form signed by a parent or guardian, must register as part of a team that includes at least one (1) adult, parent and/or guardian, and must be accompanied by the adult, parent and/or guardian at all times.**

Course: Institutions and points of interest throughout Manhattan. Participants will be provided with any combination of clues, landmarks for easier recognition and exact addresses, and will be given a task to complete at each stop. **Participants must return to the World Youth Alliance Headquarters by 6pm.**

Clothing: Participants should wear comfortable clothing and footwear suitable for the weather at that time and mild physical activity. **Event will take place rain or shine.**

Check-in: **11:30- 11:45 AM at the World Youth Alliance Headquarters** (see above address). Participants will receive a Passport (guidebook), instructions, a map of Manhattan, a subway map, and other items related to City Adventure.

Start: **12 noon sharp.** Latecomers will still be allowed to run the scavenger hunt.

Transportation: Each participant is responsible for his/her own transportation expenses incurred during the event. We suggest purchasing a 1-Day Fun Pass (Unlimited Ride MetroCard) for \$7.50 as it is the cheapest and most convenient form of transport.

Reception: **6 PM.** A reception including refreshments, snacks and a short presentation will conclude the scavenger hunt.

Awards: Prizes will be awarded for the top team scores. Scores will be based on task completion, points accumulated and overall time.
